## Intercession

- 1 Pray for the prevention and control of diseases caused by various viruses.**: Heavenly Father, we entrust all kinds of epidemics caused by viruses into Your hands. Protect our schools, fill classrooms with peace and respect, and help everyone grow not only in knowledge but also in character. When challenges arise, remind us to trust You and persevere with courage and hope.

## Spiritual Message



**Faith** is a word we often hear in the church. Most of the time, we also hear that we need to be faithful Christians. But what exactly is faith? And how can we exercise faith responsibly? I believe the word "faith" may be one of the most abused words among Christians. Sometimes, we use faith as an excuse for irresponsibility or even laziness. That is why we need a right, biblical understanding of faith.

Of course, when we talk about faith, one Bible verse often comes to mind—Hebrews 11:1: "Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."

The word faith here, in Greek, carries the meaning of assurance and conviction. Our faith is built upon an assurance given by God, and that assurance gives us hope. This reminds us that the object of our faith matters greatly. If we place our faith in worldly things that will eventually pass away, our faith becomes volatile and vulnerable. This is blind faith and irresponsible faith. True faith must be built upon God—our stronghold, our one and only God.

Faith is not something we use to avoid responsibility or remain idle. Rather, it is an active submission to and reliance on God that leads us to work diligently for His kingdom and His righteousness. Jesus tells us in John 9:4–5: "As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work. While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." Jesus said this just before healing a man who was blind from birth. During His time on earth, Jesus was always working hard and praying faithfully. He submitted to the Father in His daily work and acted with deep compassion. Therefore, let us not grow weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Amen!


