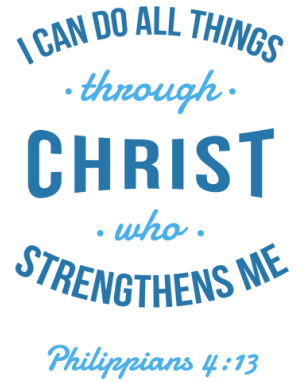

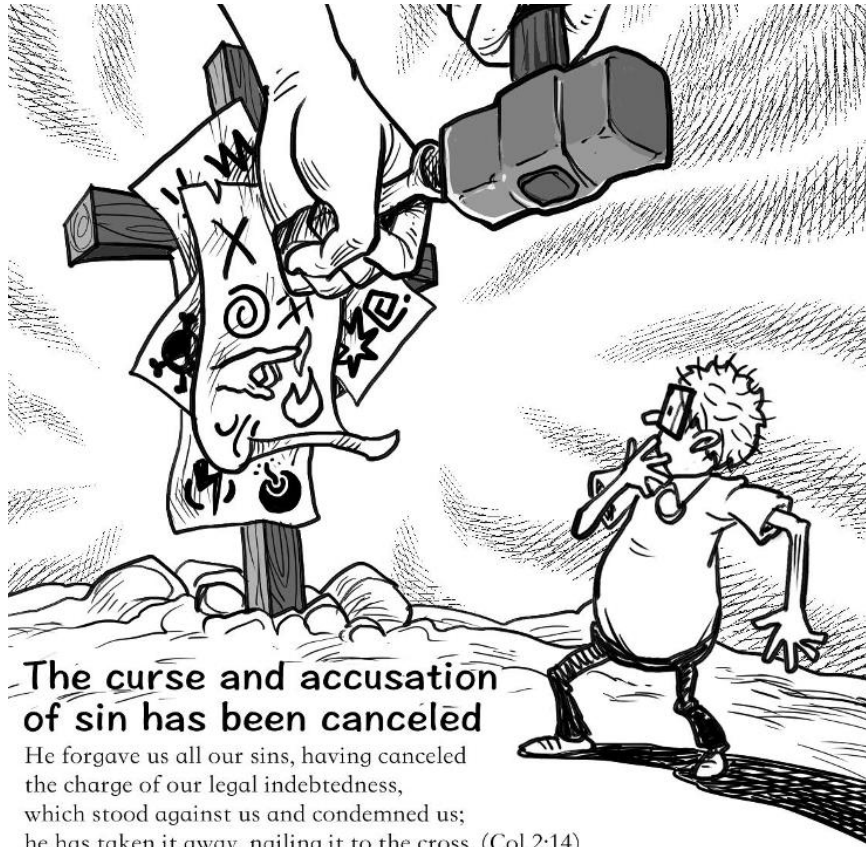
Intercession

Justification is a legal term describing the state of being made free and no longer indebted. Colossians 2:14 clearly tells us that, "having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross." Paul was talking about baptism when addressing the spiritual richness in Christ that we can ascertain as Christians.

The word "Christian" first appeared in the Bible during the time of the diaspora due to persecution. People in Jerusalem who believed in Christ were dispersed to other cities, and they spread the gospel to the towns where they settled. Initially, the term Christian carried a negative connotation, as they were called the group of people who believed in the Way, which refers to the resurrection of Christ (Acts 11:26).

It is similar to the term "Methodist" when it first referred to the Holy Club, which John and Charles Wesley and their friends started in Oxford. But now the term Christian refers to someone who is born again and is able to live a new life due to what Jesus has done.

Christ is the center of our belief because through His cross, the curse and accusation of sin have been canceled. All our sins from the past have been taken away, nailed to the cross. The blood of Jesus has washed us clean. We are no longer condemned, as we have become children of God through His cross. That's the reason why we have Holy Communion, in remembrance of what Christ has done. And, through Holy Baptism, we die to our sins and live through His righteousness. We are made new in Christ! Hallelujah! Praise be to our God, our Savior, and Redeemer!
